# **COVID-19 Update for Unions**

March 26

The number of confirmed COVID-19 cases and deaths continue to escalate.

Reported Cases of COVID-19 – from Johns Hopkins Coronavirus Resource Center <a href="https://coronavirus.jhu.edu/map.html">https://coronavirus.jhu.edu/map.html</a>

Worldwide -529,093 cases - 23,956 deaths

United States –83,507 cases –1,201 deaths (up from 65,778 cases – 942 deaths yesterday).

The U.S. now has the most reported confirmed cases in the world, with the number of cases surpassing Italy and China.

In the U.S., New York City remains the epicenter of the outbreak. As of this morning NYC reported more than 21,000 cases and 281 deaths to date.

In New York City, the first wave of the tsunami has arrived and hospitals are overwhelmed. These report from the NY Times (which I sent yesterday) describe the magnitude of the situation and the appalling conditions that healthcare workers are

Similar stories are being reported by doctors and nurses in other hospitals on the front lines.

In addition to New York, New Jersey, California and Washington continue to report large numbers that are still increasing. New emerging hot spots at Detroit, Chicago and Atlanta.

Despite the escalating number of cases and new hot spots emerging, Presiddent Trump continues to push to reopen the country and get people back to work after the "15 Days to Stop the Spread" reaches it's end this weekend. Public health experts are opposed to such an action.

In Europe, in Italy and Spain the number of daily deaths has remained high - 662 deaths in Italy and 665 deaths in Spain. Spain has extended its lockdown for another two weeks. Cases in France and the UK are also on the rise.

There are still extreme shortages in personal protective equipment and medical supplies and equipment. Efforts to direct supplies to where there are needed have helped, but are not sufficient to meet the need. Healthcare workers and other workers continue to be asked or required to do their jobs without the protection they desperately need. Some hospitals have disciplined workers who bring in personal equipment to wear. Hospitals are telling the public and the media that workers are being protected. Hospitals have told workers not to speak out about conditions or lack of equipment,

and threatened to discipline workers who do. Today, there were several reports of healthcare workers dying due to COVID infections, including a nurse at the Mt. Sinai hospital in New York City. Workers in other sectors continue to be forced to report to work, often with little or no protection and inadequate measures for physical
