PRESS RELEASE ON THE INTENDED MARCH BY PUBLIC SECTOR ASSOCIATIONS (SNAT, NAPSAWU AND SNA) TO DELIVER A PETITION ON WEDNESDAY, 20<sup>TH</sup> OCTOBER, 2021

The Nation is aware that Public Sector Associations (SNAT, NAPSAWU and SNA) had announced that on Wednesday 20th October, 2021 they will undertake a march from the Coronation Park to the Ministry of Public Service to deliver a petition.

Through this press release, the Nation is advised that the planned protest march has been prohibited by the National Commissioner in terms of Section 9(2),(3)(b) and (6) of the Public Order Act, 12 of 2017, in the interest of national security, public order and safety.

The Notice of the prohibition has already been communicated to the Convenors for their information and compliance, together with constituencies and other allies. To this end, there is no march expected to be staged tomorrow by the PSAs and the Police will be all out to ensure that the prohibition order is enforced.
