Subject: Distribuição São Paulo 'Occupation Douglas Rodrigues'.

We have been informed of a very urgent situation which has arisen in São Paulo at the Douglas Rodrigues Occupation. This situation sees about 2000 families, many of them with serious social problems, without electricity supply. The electricity distributor in the area concerned is ENEL Distribuição São Paulo. These families had an unauthorized connection to the electricity grid.

We understand that this is an occupation with unauthorized connection and use of electricity, and that several meetings have already been held between Distribuição São Paulo and representatives of the local community in order to regularise the supply of electricity;

We are aware that Distribuição São Paulo disconnected the energy supply after the fire of a transformer, caused by the same connection, as well as after subsequent and repeated attempts at new unauthorized connections;

We also know that on 14 July a meeting should have been held, to discuss the case, between the councilor of the city of São Paulo Eduardo Matarazzo Suplicy (former Senator of the Brazilian Republic) and the president of ENEL Distribuição São Paulo, the results of which we do not yet know.

With this letter, we are asking you to intervene to facilitate a solution of the situation, so that it is possible to secure the entire area and provide a regular supply of electricity. The residents of the Douglas Rodrigues Occupation want a secure and safe connection to the electricity grid and want to pay a monthly bill, the same as millions of other Brazilians.

This request of ours is addressed to you in order to obtain help for these 2000 families, who live in a disadvantaged and precarious economic / social situation, which would have further worsened without the supply of electricity. In addition, the spectre of greater "energy poverty" would bring unviable conditions throughout the area.

We know that our request does not involve easy solutions, but we also know that ENEL, in many other situations, directly or through ENEL Cuore, has demonstrated its social commitment, developing appropriate solutions consistent with the commitment made with the UN to combat "energy poverty", to give the possibility of having a dignified future to many people.

Confident in your intervention, we take this opportunity to offer you our most cordial greetings.
